RIBBON CUTTING AT SUNSET SOLAR LIGHTING ENHANCES THE WALKING TRAIL AT NORTHERN SPORTS COMPLEX

Dededo, GU (May 7, 2013) – The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) announces the addition of solar lighting for the walking trail at the Northern Sports Complex in Dededo. The event will take place on **Wednesday, May 8th, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the Dededo Sports Complex.**

GHURA completed the installation of 27 solar lights 20 foot poles along the walking trail base of the Sports Complex in Dededo. The solar lights are environmentally friendly, stand alone feature on the property. Families benefit from the extended usable hours of the walking trail after sunset.

The Department of Interior, Office of Insular Areas, enhances the walking trail project with the addition of solar lights. The project cost totaled \$169,038.00. GHURA managed the walking trail and swimming pool projects at the Northern Sports Complex.
